
The South-Central Local Workforce Development Board invites individuals, for-profit and non-profit entities, and community-based organizations to submit proposals to join the Registry of Career Service Providers of the Adults and Dislocated Workers Program, in accordance with the new service requirements established by the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act ("WIOA"), set forth in Section 134(c)(2). The activities must be designed so that participants residing in the Municipalities of Coamo, Santa Isabel, Salinas, Juana Díaz and Villalba, integrate into the Labor market.

Proposals for activities and services must emphasize the provision of activities as described in Section 134(c)(2) (A) (xii) (VI-XI) of the "WIOA" Act, in the areas broken down below:

- **Labor exchange services**
 - Includes job search and placement assistance, job and educational fairs, information on in-demand industries and occupations, and non-traditional jobs.
- **Individual or group counselling**
- **Financial Literacy Services (Financial Literacy)**
- **Educational activities related to English language proficiency**
- **Short-term pre-vocational services**
 - Development of learning skills - Development of communication - Job interview skills
 - Punctuality - Personal maintenance skills
 - Professional conduct to prepare people for jobs.
 - * Its purpose is to develop soft skills in the participant, which are personal qualities and abilities.
- **Workforce preparation activities**
 - Including activities that help individuals acquire a combination of academic skills
 - Critical thinking skills
 - Digital Literacy Skills
 - Personal management skills, use of resources, information, working with others, understanding systems and
 - Acquire skills necessary to achieve effective transition to complete post-secondary education, training, or employment.
- **Workshops at One Stop Center**

Proposals will be received with the services strictly requested.
